First transport show a classic

Expansion plans after Yattendon event success

TRANSPORT enthusiasts had something to really get their motors running over the weekend as a celebration of classic transport came to Yattendon.

The first event of its kind in the village saw more than 150 vehicles gathered in a display that delighted petrolheads from far and wide.

The free show, sponsored by Yattendon Classics and Garage, Pioneer Motors, Beechhill Garage, The Royal Oak Yattendon and Yattendon Estates, allowed visitors to see a number of rare and vintage vehicles, from military and farming heavy weights to motorbikes and push-bikes.

Organiser Eddy Stoaate said: "It was absolutely stunning. We had some really lovely vehicles come along."

"There was a Le Mans Ford and a 1920s Rolls Royce among others - it really was spectacular."

"Some of the exhibitors said they had seen vehicles here that they

hadn't seen at other shows, so we were delighted with the turnout."

Mr Stoaate said that the idea of a celebration of classic vehicles came about when a customer of Yattendon Classics and Garage, owned by his brother Roland, told them that the business had been there since 1915.

"It was a bit of a centenary celebration," he explained.

"We deliberately started small to see how it went. However, if it hadn't been on the same day as Woodcote Rally I think we could have doubled the number of exhibitors."

"We decided against making it a competition and it really was just an event for those who love their classic cars and motorvehicles."

Following the event's success, Mr Stoaate says he is hoping to expand the show in the future.

"Yattendon Estates have said they'd be happy to support us in the future, so I hope that we can make the next one even better."
